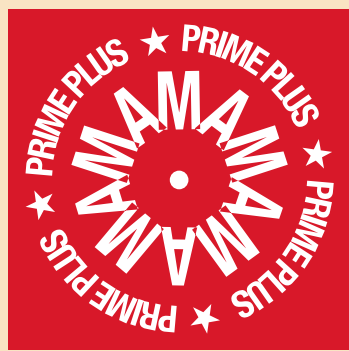

### McKenzie-Willamette Begins Open Heart Surgery in 2006

MCKENZIE-WILLAMETTE WILL PROVIDE COMPREHENSIVE CARDIOVASCULAR SERVICES BY THE END OF 2006

McKenzie-Willamette launched new cardiac services when it opened a diagnostic cardiac catheterization (cath) lab in December 2004. Within weeks, the hospital was providing much-needed diagnostic services to cardiac patients throughout central Lane County.

This year, the hospital will take cardiac services to the next level with the introduction of open heart surgery and cardiac interventions, such as balloon angioplasty and stents. Area cardiologists and other physicians have long encouraged McKenzie-Willamette to expand cardiac services in order to provide more comprehensive care for patients.

Work begins in February on construction of a dedicated cardiovascular operating room and a post-op care unit. Becky Bellingham, project coordinator, forecasts that services will be available by late 2006.

McKenzie-Willamette will combine the operating room and post-operative



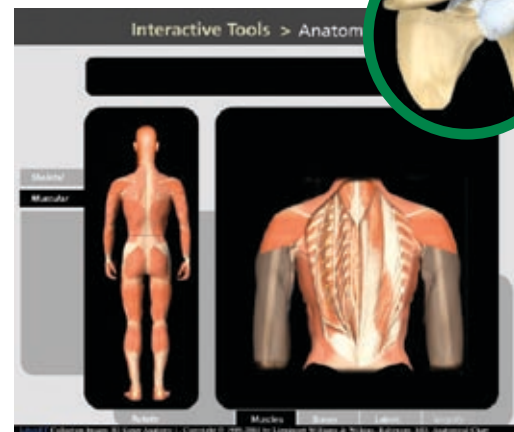
The cardiac catheterization lab opened in December 2004.

care unit in one area of the hospital's first floor—not far from the new cardiac cath lab. According to Becky, this is co-location will be an improvement for patient care. "We will be providing focused cardiovascular care by specially trained cardiovascular staff in a one-stop model where patients are admitted, treated, recovered and discharged from the same unit." This reflects best practice for providing continuity of care and results in improved efficiency, improved patient, family and staff satisfaction.

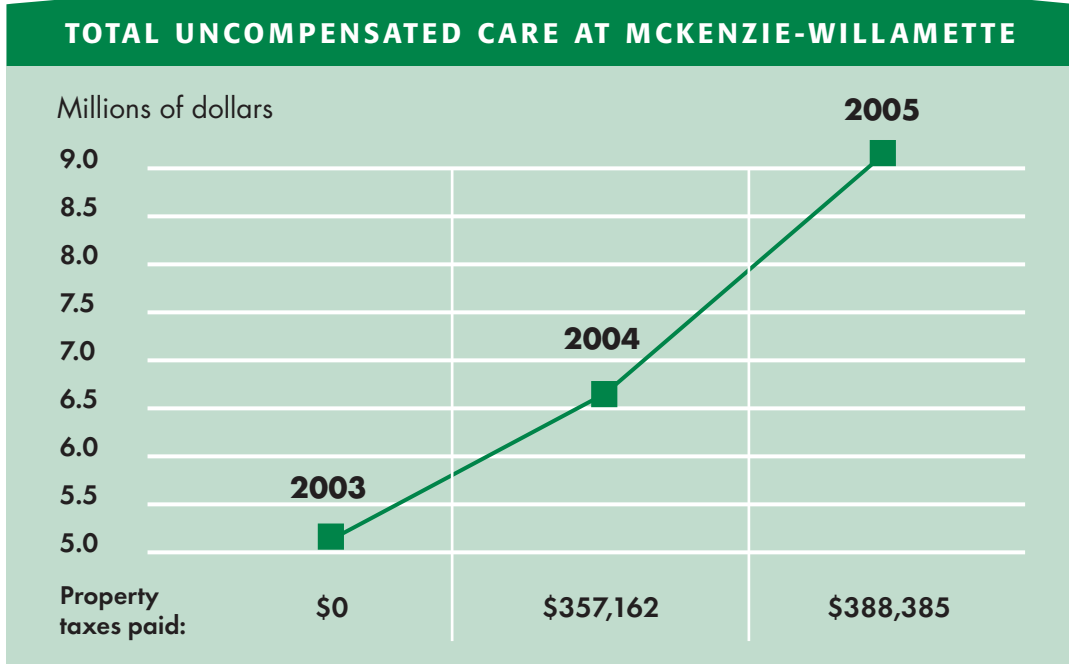

## Don't Forget Your Shots!

LANE COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICIALS ARE REMINDING EVERYONE TO STAY CURRENT ON IMMUNIZATIONS, ESPECIALLY SCHOOL KIDS WHO COULD BE KEPT FROM THE CLASSROOM

Students whose immunizations aren't current could find themselves excluded from school starting February 15. Immunization shots are required by law for children in attendance at public and private schools, preschools, childcare facilities and HeadStart programs. Nearly every place that provides care for kids outside of the home requires shots or a religious or medical exemption to stay enrolled.

Required vaccines protect against a variety of illnesses, including tetanus, polio, measles, diphtheria, mumps and rubella. For children under the age of five, shots to protect against Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib) are also required, according to the Oregon Department of Human Services.

In 2005, the Federal Drug Administration licensed Tdap, a single-dose booster that provides protection against tetanus,

diphtheria and pertussis for adolescents 11-18. Adult Tdap is also available.

"Community members should talk to their healthcare providers about immunization and the vaccines that are available," says Betsy Meredith with Lane County Public Health. "Staying up to date on your shots and keeping your children's immunization schedules current reduces risk of illness not only to yourself but to those around you."

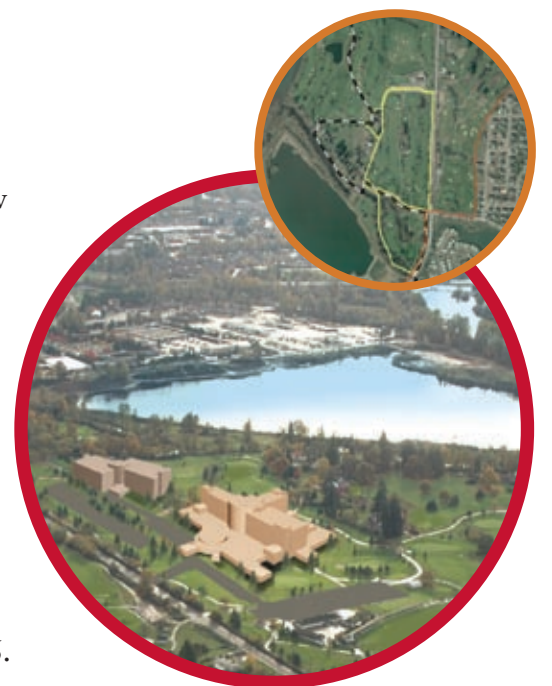

## We're Growing!

THE FUTURE OF MCKENZIE-WILLAMETTE MEDICAL CENTER HAS NEVER BEEN AS EXCITING AS IT IS TODAY

We're looking ahead to building a new, state-of-the-art facility at our preferred site of Delta Ridge. We're buying just less than 42 acres, now in use as the back nine holes of the River-Ridge Golf Complex off north Delta Highway. We have first right of refusal on the front nine and the driving range on the west side of Delta. When construction is complete, the new hospital will be about 425,000 square feet. There will be another 100,000+ square

feet of medical office space. The new facility will include 148 beds, with space to add another 50 over the next decade as needed. The new McKenzie-Willamette will include a 24-hour Level III Trauma Center ER, as well as cardiac, medical/surgical, women's and children's, diagnostic and rehabilitation services. We anticipate construction could begin as soon as soon as 2006.
